Staying informed during emergencies

- Please click on www.cgesd.org and click on the link for your child's school. There, you can subscribe to receive updates on not only school news and calendar events, but also on emergency information.

We want parents to be as informed as possible, and these are two of the best ways to have up-to-date and accurate information.
